**TUITION AND FEES**

**GRADES K-8**

Sibling rate, grades K-8 only, is \$5,468. Tuition and fees are billed at the beginning of each month and are due 10 days of invoice date.

**REGISTRATION FEE: \$300.00 per family was billed on the March invoice and is non-refundable.**

**STUDENT FEE: \$400.00 per student will be billed on the June invoice and is non-refundable. This fee covers fee listed on the student fee sheet. Student placement is guaranteed for following school year, after the Student Fee payment is cleared by the end of the billing period.**

**NEW STUDENTS: The non-refundable Registration and Student fee of \$700.00 for each new student is to be paid at time of acceptance and will guarantee placement.**

**PARENT VOLUNTEER HOURS and MANDATORY MEETINGS**

An important component to your child's education is your participation at school events. When children see their parents helping out at school, they know that "school is important!" Each family is responsible for volunteering at least 15 hours a year. These hours are to be completed during the period of May 1, 2011 through April 30, 2012. After April 30, parents will be given a statement with the number of hours completed. Hours not completed are charged \$10.00 an hour. The balance due will be billed on the May invoice. It is the **parents' duty** to keep track of their parent volunteer hours in order to verify the hours completed. Parents may choose to pay a \$150 fee to the PTG fund and not participate in parent hours.

**Mandatory Meetings:** There are two mandatory parent meetings each year. Parents may be asked to attend up to three mandatory meetings per year.

**FUND-RAISING OBLIGATION**

Tuition alone does not cover the school's operating budget. Fund-raising is needed to cover the difference. In the past, the PTG and school sponsored fund-raisers have assisted our school in providing supplies and have enhanced various educational programs for the benefit of our students. **In 2011-2012, Four mandatory fund-raisers are: Chocolate-catalogue drive (min. \$180 per student), and three school raffles (min. \$125 per student). We will also have the Annual Student Pledge and other fundraisers. Thank you for your generous support.**

**PARENT OPTION**

Parents may choose not to participate in the mandatory fundraising and parent volunteer responsibilities by making a tax-deductible donation to the school of \$725 per student. Mandatory parent meetings are still required. Parents may also wish to make additional tax-deductible pledge contributions to assist us in meeting our operational needs. All tax-deductible checks need to be made out to **St. Mary's Chinese Mission.**
